Prefixes: un-, re-, pre-, dis- — Answer Key

un+happy = **unhappy** (not happy) re+read = **reread** (read again)

un+lock = **unlock** (open what was locked) re+build = **rebuild** (build again)

pre+view = **preview** (a look before) dis+agree = **disagree** (not agree)

un+kind = **unkind** (not kind) re+fill = **refill** (fill again)

un+lock = **unlock** (open again) re+read = **reread** (read again)

pre+school = **preschool** (before school) dis+obey = **disobey** (not obey)

un+tie = **untie** (undo a knot) re+build = **rebuild** (build again)
