$$18/8 = 2 \frac{2}{8} \quad 26/8 = 3 \frac{2}{8} \quad 18/7 = 2 \frac{4}{7}$$

$$33/6 = 5 \frac{3}{6} \quad 29/7 = 4 \frac{1}{7} \quad 26/5 = 5 \frac{1}{5}$$

$$29/9 = 3 \frac{2}{9} \quad 21/8 = 2 \frac{5}{8} \quad 19/8 = 2 \frac{3}{8}$$

$$10/8 = 1 \frac{2}{8} \quad 23/4 = 5 \frac{3}{4}$$
