$$40/7 = 5 \frac{5}{7} \quad 44/8 = 5 \frac{4}{8} \quad 45/8 = 5 \frac{5}{8}$$

$$7/4 = 1 \frac{3}{4} \quad 20/6 = 3 \frac{2}{6} \quad 34/8 = 4 \frac{2}{8}$$

$$9/6 = 1 \frac{3}{6} \quad 16/6 = 2 \frac{4}{6} \quad 51/9 = 5 \frac{6}{9}$$

$$4/3 = 1 \frac{1}{3} \quad 38/9 = 4 \frac{2}{9}$$
