$$5+5\times 12 = 65 \quad 4+3\times 9 = 31$$

$$(2+3)\times 8 = 40 \quad (9+2)\times 9 = 99$$

$$8+8\times 8 = 72 \quad 8+7-3 = 12$$

$$3+9\times 2 = 21 \quad (7+5)\times 4 = 48$$

$$6\times 5-2 = 28 \quad 7+6-4 = 9$$

$$3\times 2-4 = 2 \quad 9\times 6-3 = 51$$

$$5+9-5 = 9 \quad 6\times 7-5 = 37$$
